The YouthHack Academy is a semester-long endeavor to teach high school students about web development and innovation in the context of entrepreneurship. The two tracks (innovation or technology) will be presented in 3-hour workshops that will be facilitated at different high schools across the National Capital Region. The goal of the Academy is to equip high school students with the necessary technological and innovative skills that are becoming more in-demand in the continually evolving workplace.



// TECHNOLOGY TRACK

The technology track is a 3-hour outcome-based workshop on web design. In this workshop, participants will learn the basic functionalities of HTML and CSS while applying these to design their own online resume. The goal of this session is to empower Filipino students to venture into coding by eliminating the initial intimidation surrounding this skill which will be useful in the 21st century work environment.

// INNOVATION TRACK

The innovation track is a 3-hour workshop on innovation and entrepreneurship that focuses on applying thinking tools in generating ideas. The session will discuss the basics of developing an innovative mindset and tackle useful techniques such as Creative Problem Solving, a more comprehensive take on brainstorming. Individual and group exercises on utilizing mental models for businesses will be integrated into the discussion to give the participants an opportunity to apply their learnings to real-life situations. The goal of the session is to enable young minds to apply innovation in their everyday lives and lead them to explore a career in innovative entrepreneurship.
